Dr. Qin Dahe is an internationally recognized scientist in glacier (including Antarctic ice sheet) and ice core studies relating to paleoclimate and paleoenvironment. His current major research efforts include present process associated with the current environmental and climatic variation; climate and environment assessment; and glacier change in the context of global change. He has the experience of chairing, as the chief scientist, the projects supported by National Natural Science Foundation of China, basic research projects

sponsored by the Ministry of Science and Technology of China, the Key Innovation Projects of Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS) as well as related bilateral cooperation programs. He has been overseeing the Scientific Assessment on Climate, Ecology and Environment of Western China in recent years.

At EC-56 of WMO, Dr. Qin was appointed as the chairman of the Inter-commission Task Group on IPY, which was set up to support the IPY Joint Committee co-sponsored by WMO and ICSU, and to coordinate activities related to the implementation of IPY within WMO.
